for he wrote of me.

John 5:47,  
But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?

# Percentage of Bible Prophetic in Nature

31,124 verses in the Bible

8,352 verses are predictive in nature (27%)

There are 737 specific prophecies. Some of these prophecies are repeated in the Bible bringing the total number of prophecy statements to 1,817.

610 of the 737 prophecies have already been fulfilled. There are 127 prophecies that are yet unfulfilled and are connected with the Second Coming of Christ.

# THE 291 PROPHECIES OF MOSES

## 2,007 of 5,852 Verses

**GENESIS:** 212 of 1,533 verses are prophetic in nature = 14% of book. There are 77 distinct prophecies. 22 of the 77 prophecies are to be fulfilled by Christ.

**EXODUS:** 487 of 1,213 verses or 40% is predictive in nature. There are 69 distinct predictions.

**LEVITICUS:** 506 of 859 verses or 59% involves prophecy. There are 37 distinct prophecies.

**NUMBERS:** 458 of 1,288 verses or 36% is prophetic. There are 50 separate predictions.

**DEUTERONOMY:** 344 of 959 verses or 36% is predictive in nature. There are 58 specific prophecies.

# **The Different Literary Forms Used in Biblical Prophecies**

- 1. Verbal forms - simple oracles seen in normal, customary language, explicit predictions = 1,183**
- 2. Verbal forms using figurative language = 168**
- 3. Non-verbal forms - symbolic predictions as seen in object lessons, dreams = 86**
- 4. Non-verbal forms seen in typology = 380**

**Total: 1,817 prophecies**

# Prophecy #1 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: Christ's Dominion Over Creation

Genesis 1:26,

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

Genesis 1:28,

And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

**FULFILLMENT:** Hebrews 2:8, "But now we do not yet see all things subjected to him" - Millennium

# OUR RESPONSE

1. To Give God our Heart and Let Him Rule our Heart - to have dominion over us
2. To Worship the Second Adam - the Creator and Ruler of the Universe.
3. To look forward to the day when there will be order and peace in all of God's creation.
4. Psalm 8:6, Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all *things* under his feet:

# **Prophecy #2 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: A Physical Rest Day to Worship God**

**Genesis 2:3,**

**And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it:  
because that in it he had rested from all his work which  
God created and made.**

**FULFILLMENT: The spiritual rest Christ provides through  
His atoning work which leads to the eternal rest (Hebrews  
4:9-11).**

# OUR RESPONSE

1. To enter into spiritual rest by believing in Jesus for salvation. Hebrews 4:10-11, For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his. (4:11) Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.
2. To look forward to the eternal rest with God, both physically and spiritually. Hebrews 4:9, There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.

# Prophecy #5 of 77 in Genesis

## Explicit Verbal and Typology = Prediction of the Curse on all of Creation by One Man's Sin

Genesis 3:6,

And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

Genesis 3:17-19,

(3:17) And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat *of* it all the days of thy life. (3:18) Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; (3:19)

3:19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou *art*, and unto dust shalt thou return.

**FULFILLMENT:** Christ our representative head performing one great deed of righteousness

# THE FULFILLMENT

ROMANS 5:12-19,

(5:12) Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: <sup>13</sup> (For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law. <sup>14</sup> Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come. <sup>15</sup> But not as the offence, so also *is* the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, *which is* by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many. <sup>16</sup> And not as *it was* by one that sinned, so *is* the gift: for the judgment was by one to condemnation, but the free gift *is* of many offences unto justification. <sup>17</sup> For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) <sup>18</sup> Therefore as by the offence of one *judgment came* upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one *the free gift came* upon all men unto justification of life. <sup>19</sup> For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

# OUR RESPONSE

- 1. We must acknowledge that through the sin of one head we had sin imputed to us. We must confess we are sinners by nature and by choice and that the wages of sin is death.**
- 2. We must believe our sin was imputed to Him on the cross. That Jesus bore all our sins. He became sin for us.**
- 3. We must believe that through the righteousness and righteous act of One we can have the righteousness of God imputed to our account.**

# **Prophecy #6 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: Enmity between Satan and the Woman**

Genesis 3:15a,

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman,  
and between thy seed and her seed;  
it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

**FULFILLMENT:** Eve will be reconciled to God as well as a remnant of the human race because of Christ's work!

# OUR RESPONSE

1. To acknowledge that before we were saved we were on the wrong side of the equation. We were of the seed of the Serpent. We belonged to Satan and were at enmity with God and His true children.
2. We must be reconciled to God by repenting of sin and believing in Christ's death on the cross.
3. We must be involved in a life-long ministry of reconciliation.

# **Prophecy #7 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: Enmity between Satan's seed and her "Seed"**

Genesis 3:15b,

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman,  
and between thy seed and her seed;

it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

**FULFILLMENT:** Christ will be the "seed." He will be the means through Whom the victory will be accomplished for mankind!

# **Prophecy #8 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Figurative Verbal: The “Seed” will destroy the Serpent**

Genesis 3:15c,

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman,  
and between thy seed and her seed;  
it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

**FULFILLMENT:** Christ crushed the head of Satan at the Cross (Hebrews 2:14-15). Satan will lose the war in heaven, will be imprisoned in the abyss in the millennium, and will abide in the lake of fire for eternity!

# OUR RESPONSE

1. To identify who the “Seed” is.
2. To enjoy the spiritual victory now!
3. To not fear death, but to look forward to being with Christ, which is gain!
4. To praise God for the defeat of our enemy Satan.
5. To watch the demise of the evil one because of the cross. To watch his defeat in heaven, to watch his imprisonment in the abyss in the millennium and to watch him being cast into the lake of fire for eternity.

# **Prophecy #9 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: Blood Sacrifice of an Animal**

**Genesis 3:21,**  
**Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.**

**FULFILLMENT: God justifying sinners on the basis of Christ's sacrifice and clothing the believer in His righteousness**

# Prophecy #9 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: Blood Sacrifice of an Animal

Genesis 4:4,

And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:

Genesis 8:20-21,

(8:20) And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. (8:21) And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart *is* evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

# **Prophecy #9 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: Sacrifice of an Animal**

**Genesis 31:54,**

**Then Jacob offered sacrifice upon the mount, and called his brethren to eat bread: and they did eat bread, and tarried all night in the mount.**

**Genesis 46:1,**

**And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beersheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.**

# OUR RESPONSE

1. We must realize that every animal sacrifice in the OT was a type or a picture of the ultimate blood sacrifice for sin - the death of Christ on the cross, **THE LAMB OF GOD.**
2. We must acknowledge that the only way to be reconciled to God and to be clothed in His righteousness is to believe in the sacrifice of God's only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ.

# Prophecy #13 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: Safety in the Ark

Genesis 7:23,

And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained *alive*, and they that *were* with him in the ark.

Genesis 8:1,

And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

Genesis 8:4,

And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Arara.

Genesis 8:16-19,

(8:16) Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee. (8:17) Bring forth with thee every living thing that *is* with thee, of all flesh, *both* of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth. (8:18) And Noah went forth, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him: (8:19) Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, *and* whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.

**FULFILLMENT: Spiritual Safety in Christ and His salvation**

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. We must recognize that God will judge sin in our lives.**
- 2. There is a Judgment Day coming. To avoid the wrath of God we must be safe “in Christ.”**
- 3. Christ is our spiritual ark! He is the one and only door to heaven. We must enter in by faith!**
- 4. We must work hard to get all of our family members safe in the ark!**

# **Prophecy #15 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: Life is in the Blood**

**Genesis 9:4,**  
**But flesh with the life thereof, *which is* the blood thereof,**  
**shall ye not eat.**

**Fulfillment: Eternal life is received by faith in Christ and His sacrificial blood. “Without shedding of blood is no remission is no remission/forgiveness” (Hebrews 9:22).**

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. We must value life! We must be pro-life!**
- 2. We must value the death of Christ and the shedding of His blood.**
- 3. We must realize that there is no forgiveness, no eternal life granted apart from the shedding of Christ's blood.**

# Prophecy #16 of 77 in Genesis

## Explicit Verbal: The Noachian Covenant

Genesis 9:8-17,

(9:8) And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, (9:9) And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you; (9:10) And with every living creature that *is* with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth. (9:11) And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. (9:12) And God said, This *is* the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that *is* with you, for perpetual generations: (9:13) I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth. (9:14) And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: (9:15) And I will remember my covenant, which *is* between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. (9:16) And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that *is* upon the earth. (9:17) And God said unto Noah, This *is* the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that *is* upon the earth.

**FULFILLMENT:** The death of the Testator Jesus Christ

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. We must view God as being Just and Merciful!**
- 2. The extension of mercy is based on the nature of God and the death of the Testator of the Noachian Covenant - a unilateral testament/covenant.**
- 3. To enjoy God's mercy forever one must repent of their sin and believe in the death of the Testator, Jesus Christ.**

# **Prophecy #18 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: The Blessed Line of Shem**

Genesis 9:26a,


And he said, Blessed *be* the LORD God of Shem;  
and Canaan shall be his servant.

Genesis 28:13,

“LORD God of Abraham”

**THE FULFILLMENT:** The blessed *Messiah* will be a  
descendent of Shem.

# **OUR RESPONSE**



- 1. We should look for the blessing upon the line of Shem in the Person of Jesus Christ.**
- 2. We should seek to be a blessing to the descendants of Shem - Israel!**

# Prophecy #25 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: Altars for Sacrifices

Genesis 12:7b-8;

And the LORD appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land: and there builded he an altar unto the LORD, who appeared unto him. (12:8) And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, *having* Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto the LORD, and called upon the name of the LORD.

Genesis 13:4,

Unto the place of the altar, which he had made there at the first: and there Abram called on the name of the LORD.

Genesis 13:18,

Then Abram removed *his* tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which *is* in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.

**FULFILLMENT:** In Christ as the place of true offering to God

# Prophecy #25 of 77 in Genesis

Genesis 22:9,

And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.

Genesis 26:25,

And he builded an altar there, and called upon the name of the LORD, and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well.

Genesis 33:20,

And he erected there an altar, and called it Elelohe-Israel.

# Prophecy #25 of 77 in Genesis

Genesis 35:1,

And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother.

Genesis 35:3,

And let us arise, and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went.

Genesis 35:7,

And he built there an altar, and called the place Elbethel: because there God appeared unto him, when he fled from the face of his brother.

Genesis 35:9,

And God appeared unto Jacob again, when he came out of Padanaram, and blessed him.

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. We must realize that the ultimate invitation is not to invite someone to the altar in front of the church but to invite someone to come to Jesus Christ - the ultimate Place of sacrifice.**
- 2. We must realize that Jesus is both the Altar and the Sacrifice required for access to God.**

# **Prophecy #26 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: Melchizedek as King**

Genesis 14:18a,

And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.

**FULFILLMENT:** Jesus is the King of Kings, whose righteousness leads to a perfect reign of peace

# **Prophecy #27 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: Melchizedek as High Priest**

**Genesis 14:18b,**  
**And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.**

**FULFILLMENT: Jesus is the perfect High Priest**

# **Prophecy #28 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: Abram Gave Tithes to Melchizedek**

**Genesis 14:19-20,**

**(14:19) And he blessed him, and said, Blessed *be* Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: (14:20) And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.**

**FULFILLMENT: The Corresponding Greatness of Christ**

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. We must worship Christ as our King of Kings, Prophet and High Priest!**
- 2. We should give more than our tithes and offerings. We should give Him our all. We need to live 100% of the time as a “living sacrifice.”**
- 3. We have a great King to govern our lives.**
- 4. We have a merciful High Priest in heaven Who is touched by our infirmities and invites us to come to Him in prayer in our time of trouble!**

# **Prophecy #30 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: The Abrahamic Covenant**

Genesis 15:10-11,

(15:10) And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not. (15:11) And when the fowls came down upon the carcasses, Abram drove them away.

Genesis 15:17-18a;

(15:17) And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces. (15:18) In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:

**Fulfilment: The violent death of the Testator, Jesus Christ**

# Prophecy #30 of 77 in Genesis

## Explicit Verbal: The Abrahamic Covenant

Genesis 17:2-4a,

(17:2) And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly. (17:3) And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying, (17:4) As for me, behold, my covenant *is* with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations.

Genesis 17:7-9,

(17:7) And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee. (17:8) And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God. (17:9) And God said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations.

**FULFILLMENT: The Violent Death of the Testator Jesus Christ**

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. Individually and as a nation we should bless Abraham because of the covenant relationship between God and Abraham and his descendants.**
- 2. We should recognize and respect the land promises given to Israel.**
- 3. We need to acknowledge that we are blessed by the Jews: the recipients of Scripture and the Messiah.**

# Prophecy #42 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: The Ordinance of Circumcision

Genesis 17:10-14,

(17:10) This *is* my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised. (17:11) And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you. (17:12) And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which *is* not of thy seed.

(17:13) He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant. (17:14) And the uncircumcised man child whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken my covenant.

# Prophecy #42 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: The Ordinance of Circumcision

Genesis 17:23-27,

(17:23) And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him. (17:24) And Abraham was ninety years old and nine, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin. (17:25) And Ishmael his son was thirteen years old, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin. (17:26) In the selfsame day was Abraham circumcised, and Ishmael his son. (17:27) And all the men of his house, born in the house, and bought with money of the stranger, were circumcised with him.

# Prophecy #42 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: The Ordinance of Circumcision

Genesis 21:4,

And Abraham circumcised his son Isaac being eight days old, as God had commanded him.

Genesis 34:14-17,

(34:14) And they said unto them, We cannot do this thing, to give our sister to one that is uncircumcised; for that *were* a reproach unto us: (34:15) But in this will we consent unto you: If ye will be as we *be*, that every male of you be circumcised; (34:16) Then will we give our daughters unto you, and we will take your daughters to us, and we will dwell with you, and we will become one people. (34:17) But if ye will not hearken unto us, to be circumcised; then will we take our daughter, and we will be gone.

**THE FULFILLMENT:** Christ's spiritual circumcision of the sinner and the sinner putting off the works of the flesh in repentance

# Prophecy #42 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: The Ordinance of Circumcision

Genesis 34:22-24,

(34:22) Only herein will the men consent unto us for to dwell with us, to be one people, if every male among us be circumcised, as they *are* circumcised. (34:23) *Shall* not their cattle and their substance and every beast of theirs *be* ours? only let us consent unto them, and they will dwell with us. (34:24) And unto Hamor and unto Shechem his son hearkened all that went out of the gate of his city; and every male was circumcised, all that went out of the gate of his city.

**THE FULFILLMENT:** Christ's spiritual circumcision of the sinner and the sinner putting off the works of the flesh in repentance

# OUR RESPONSE

1. Every sinner needs regeneration - the new birth, a circumcised heart. This radical heart surgery is the work of God!
2. The sinner's responsibility in salvation is to repent, to put off the works of the flesh and to believe in the gospel. Repentance is the radical severance of sin from one's life!

# **Prophecy #44 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Typology: The Offering of Abraham's Son**

**Genesis 22:2**

**“... Isaac, whom thou LOVEST”**

**Genesis 22:8,**

**And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.**

**FULFILLMENT: The death of God's only-begotten Son on Mount Moriah (Jerusalem)**

# Prophecy #44 of 77 in Genesis

## Typology: The Offering of Abraham's Son

Genesis 22:2-3,

(22:2) And he said, Take now thy son, thine only *son* Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. (22:3) And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

Genesis 22:6-7,

(22:6) And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid *it* upon Isaac his son; and he took the fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together. (22:7) And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here *am* I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where *is* the lamb for a burnt offering?

Genesis 22:10 And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

Genesis 22:13 And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind *him* a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. To recognize that Jehovah-Jireh has provided the ultimate burnt offering for sin - the sacrifice of His only begotten Son!**
- 2. To believe in the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ.**
- 3. To acknowledge God's great love for His Son and for us!**
- 4. To tell of others of the love of God.**

# **Prophecy #46 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: The Seed that shall Bless all Nations - the Source**

Genesis 22:18a,

And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Genesis 26:4c,


And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;

# **Prophecy #67 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: The Coming of Shiloh from the tribe of Judah**

Genesis 49:10a,

The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him *shall* the gathering of the people *be*.

**THE FULFILLMENT: The Second Coming of Jesus who was born in the royal line of Judah**

# **OUR RESPONSE**

- 1. To recognize the royal line of Jesus - that He is the ultimate King of kings who will reign eternally. The scepter will never depart from His omnipotent hands.**
- 2. We should bow down to worship the King!**
- 3. We should anticipate His second coming!**

# **Prophecy #68 of 77 in Genesis**

## **Explicit Verbal: The Gathering of His People**

**Genesis 49:10b,**

**The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him *shall* the gathering of the people *be*.**

**THE FULFILLMENT:** The resurrection of Old Testament Saints at the Revelation aspect of the Second Coming of Jesus Christ. Also included for millennial purposes would be the Tribulation Saints and the Raptured Saints from the Church Age.
